By 1856, the records indicate they are residents of San Ignacio, Chihuahua, Mexico. Daughter Alfonsa Silva marries Benino Torres in Las Cruces, 1877. They settle at El Colorado. A small street is named for Benino Torres. It intersects with Victor Duran St. at El Colorado, today's small village of Rodey near Hatch, New Mexico.
